Overview of Organization

[American Muslim Health Professionals](#) (AMHP)'s mission is to strengthen the impact of Muslim health professionals to improve the health and wellness of all Americans. AMHP brings together a community of activists, health advocates, clinicians and other health professionals committed to public health, civic engagement and social justice. AMHP's three core areas of focus are professional development, mental health and advocacy for underserved communities.

Vision: To be a leader in improving public health, through efforts inspired by the Islamic tradition.

Position Description

The Mental Health Research Fellow will work with the Project Lead in overseeing all aspects of a research study evaluating the impact of AMHP's Mental Health First Aid Training Program. The Fellow will be responsible for ensuring that study recruitment, data collection and analysis is implemented as planned. S/he will also be responsible for the epidemiologic aspects of the study, including design and data analysis.

Duties and Responsibilities

The Mental Health Research Fellow will perform duties, such as, but not limited to the following:

- Oversee IRB procedures
- Conduct qualitative aspects of the study including focus groups, interviews, and analysis
- Ensure that the recruitment, data collection and analysis are executed as planned
- Assist Project Lead and Program Coordinator in leading staff operations and team meetings
- Maintain timeline and schedule of study activities
- Assist Project Lead in final report and drafting manuscripts for conferences and/or publications
- Sharing insights and data findings with participants

Requirements

- MPH or other Master's degree preferred. Preference will be given to individuals with a degree in public health, psychology, social work, counseling or a related field
- 1-2 years of experience conducting research in an academic or other setting
- Proven experience as a qualitative researcher
- A working understanding of outcome measures and evaluation methodologies

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities

- Excellent technical writing and communication skills
- Perceptive to power relations within community organizations.
- Excellent attention to detail and skills in organizing resources and prioritizing tasks
- Committed to engaging in honest reflexivity.
- Analytical and problem-solving skills
- Knowledge of mental health and specifically mental health first aid is a plus

Time Commitment & Compensation

- This fellowship position is part-time and temporary, requiring 10-15 hours per week for approximately 6 months. The fellow will receive a monthly stipend.
