### Overview of Organizations

[American Muslim Health Professionals](#) (AMHP) is a national non-profit organization focused on fostering collaboration between Muslim professionals from diverse sector of healthcare who seeking to advance public health, social justice, and civic engagement within their communities. AMHP's core areas of focus are mental health, advocacy for underserved communities and professional development.

[Muslim Anti-Racism Collaborative](#) (MuslimARC) is an education organization working to address the intersections of Islamophobia, xenophobia, & systemic racism. The Muslim Anti-Racism Collaborative (MuslimARC) creates spaces to learn and develop racial equity, connects multifaith and multiracial networks using digital media, dialogue, and storytelling, and cultivates solutions for racial justice through research, curriculum development, and strategic planning.

### Position Description

AMHP is working with an MuslimARC to develop a health equity curriculum focused on the needs of Muslim patients. The curriculum will emphasize anti-racism approaches and cultural sensitivity issues to consider in promoting health equity, which includes speaking specifically to the diversity of Muslim populations.

The prospective Health Equity Curriculum Fellow will work with AMHP and MuslimARC to conduct research on the healthcare aspects of the curriculum to optimize the content development and to potentially develop new content including development of scenarios of health equity challenges. You will also work closely with the Health Policy and Advocacy Manager to ensure collaboration and successful completion of tasks.

### Knowledge, Skills & Abilities

Academic Requirements:

- Health equity fellow in training or junior faculty
- Post-professional graduate/professional student enrolled in healthcare related Masters/PhD program with practicum requirements or additional research requirements

Other Skills:

- Excellent technical writing and communication skills
- A working understanding of outcome measures and evaluation methodologies aimed at assessing program effectiveness
- Excellent attention to detail and skills in organizing resources and prioritizing tasks

- Analytical and problem-solving skills
- Knowledge of health equity is a plus
- Skills in basic microsoft applications

**Time Commitment:** This position is part-time and temporary, requiring 10-15 hours per week.

**Timeline for Completion:** January 20, 2024

**Compensation:** The Fellow will receive a payment of \$25/hour over the stipulated timeline of 3 months.

**Objective:** Coordinate activities related to the health equity curriculum development project and to develop content for the curriculum.

Milestone 1: Coordinate weekly meetings and activities

- Coordinate meeting series
- Review of pending items
- Initiate workflow and follow up on pending items

Milestone 2: Content Development – Case Descriptions

- Develop case descriptions for inclusion in the curriculum.
- Coordinate content review with extended team

Milestone 3: Coordinate implementation logistics

- Identify potential customer base to pilot curriculum
- Incorporate updates to curriculum based on client feedback
- Assist activities related to the launch
- Assist with any activities for any testing needed for launch

*All milestones will conclude with a written report and analysis, which will be shared with the AMHP team for review and discussion.*
